CATCH THE BUS!

Universal Bus – The University bus for everyone

The Universal bus service links Eddington with the city, the railway station and the Cambridge Biomedical Campus (including Addenbrooke's).

The service operates a 15 minute frequency Monday to Friday and a 20 minute service on Saturdays. Discounts apply for University card holders; show the driver your card and pay just £1 per journey. Non-university card holders also get a reduce journey price of £2. Fares must be paid in cash to the driver.

JOIN THE CAR CLUB!

An E-Car club vehicle is parked on the Eddington site, giving you access to a car when you need it – perfectly maintained without the hassle or expense of ownership. Residents benefit from free membership and two hours of drive time.

Located across Cambridge (including in car parking spaces on University sites) you will also be able to find Zipcars. University staff can use the vehicles for travelling at work or for personal use.

At Eddington, we have invested in connectivity, creating a network of routes to help you get to your destination. If you need any support planning journeys around Cambridge, you can request a personalised travel plan (PTP) session with the Transport Coordinator, email travel@nwc.cambridge.co.uk to arrange your appointment.

GET ON YOUR BIKE!

A number of bikes are available to University Staff to hire from Eddington, along with baby seats, helmets and other equipment, on a try before you buy basis for £10. Residents can then purchase the bike and accessories at a discounted rate. To take advantage of this, contact the Transport Coordinator on the email above for more details.

When buying your own bike, the University Cycle to Work Scheme allows staff to buy bicycles and bike equipment tax-free via a salary sacrifice. Staff members could also qualify for a travel to work loan, visit the University's HR website for more details.

Cycle training and maintenance will be offered to residents periodically, keep an eye out on Portal for dates.

EDDINGTON CYCLING AND WALKING NETWORK

Use the map to plan your cycling and walking routes to Girton, West Cambridge, the city and beyond. Primary network, the Ridgeway, is open to the south and the north - the section by the Community Square will be open later in the year.
