- Sign the online Matriculation form as soon as you're sent it by the Postgraduate Office (around 27 Sept). This is the official record of becoming a member of Cambridge University.
- Watch for an email from PG Admin with your Postgraduate Tutor allocation and then for an email from your Tutor to set up an initial meeting time.
- Buy an academic gown (see date and time above)
- Download UPay app when sent an email from College catering office – used to sign up for formals including Freshers' Formal – make contact if you have trouble with UPay
- Sign Tenancy Agreement if living in College accommodation
- Register with a Doctors' Surgery – see Health Centre information on our website
- Complete and submit the Health Questionnaire sent by the College Nurses as instructed.
- ID checking and Uni card pickup on arrival – please take photo ID with you when collecting your University card. Those living in Swirles or living out can obtain their cards from Swirles Lodge as of 20 Sept. Those in other College properties should obtain their cards from the Main Site Lodge as of 20 Sept. If the card isn't there, please email the address below.
- If studying on a Student Visa, you have been sent instructions on how to generate an e-visa sharecode and which documents you need to present at the scanning appointment that you need to book – we can resend the link if needs be. Must have this completed before you begin study.
- Pay your first College bill by the deadline (you'll receive it around the end of September).
